1966-Fast-AF Air Filter Cleaning instructions (NO OIL Required!)

- Shake or tap the filter to remove any large particles of dirt, bugs, leaves, debris, that might have gotten trapped / caught by the filtering material.
- Fill a bucket with a tsp of dish soap per gallon of WARM tap water solution. Submerge the filter in the solution so that the entire filter surface is covered and let it soak for 8 10 minutes. We prefer Dawn dish soap.
- Rinse the air filter media out with WARM water from the inside of the filter to help push out any dirt or debris. DO NOT use a high-pressure cleaner on the filter media.
- Once rinsed thoroughly, shake the filter to get as much of the water out of it as possible and let it air dry. DO NOT use a hair dryer, compressed air or any other kind of heat source to dry the filter.
- Repeat the process if necessary.
- Once the filter surface is clean and dry, you can reinstall the filter back into the vehicle.

DO NOT OIL THIS FILTER MEDIA!!!

For performance applications it is recommend cleaning the filter every 5000 miles to ensure optimal performance. In a "normal" street application it is recommended to clean the filter whenever the media looks dirty or discolored from dirt.
